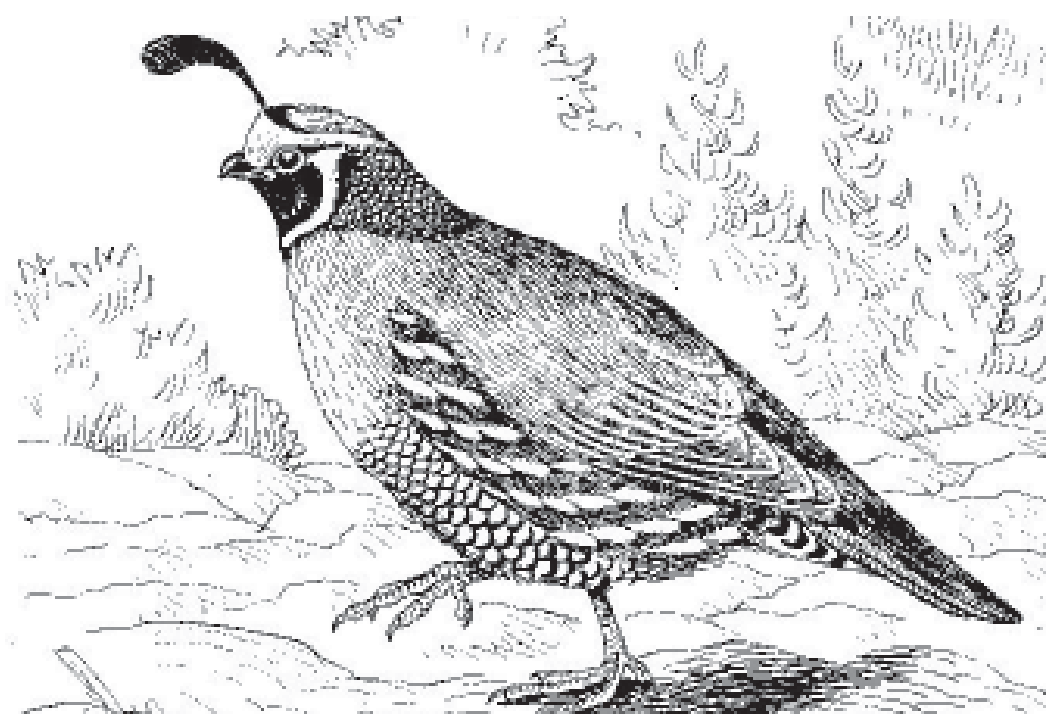

SAN FRANCISCO IS HOME TO AN ASTOUNDING DIVERSITY OF INDIGENOUS WILDLIFE AND PLANTS. BUT MANY OF THESE SPECIES ARE ON THE BRINK OF EXTINCTION, AND UNLESS WE PROTECT THEIR HABITATS THESE SPECIES COULD BE LOST FOREVER.

ON **JULY 26 AT 8:30 AM** IN **CITY HALL ROOM 416**, SAN FRANCISCO'S RECREATION AND PARKS COMMISSION WILL HOLD A HEARING ON A BOLD AND PROGRESSIVE PLAN TO PRESERVE SAN FRANCISCO'S SIGNIFICANT NATURAL RESOURCE AREAS. BUT SAN FRANCISCO'S TOP WILDLIFE VILLAINS ARE SCHEMING TO STOP THE PLAN, AND IF WILDLIFE ADVOCATES REMAIN SILENT THESE VILLAINS WILL SUCCEED.
