 - * San Francisco gum plant *Grindelia hirsutula var. maritima*
 - * Douglas iris *Iris douglasiana*
 - * purple needle grass *Nassella pulchra*
 - * California phacelia *Phacelia californica*
 - yerba buena *Satureja douglasii*
 - * blue eyed grass *Sisyrinchium bellum*

KEY

- * planted in the Corridor
- ° shrubs, perennials, and vines that become large - not for the smaller Green Hairstreak habitat gardens
- for moister sites, e.g. north facing and/or clayey soil

Larval food plant: plant (or family of plants) where the female lays her eggs. The Acmon Blue (*Plebejus acmon*) lays eggs on same plants as the Green Hairstreak (*Callyphors viridis*).

Nectar plant: where adult butterflies receive water and nutrients
